

The University

The Central University of Bihar (CUB) is a body corporate set up by an Act of the Parliament called the Central Universities Act, 2009 (25 of 2009). This Act which is available on University website at www.cub.ac.in provides basic legal framework for the University including its academics, administration and other aspects. The University is presently located at the premises of Birla Institute of Technology- Patna (Camp Office: BIT Campus, PO: B.V. College, Patna - 800014). Permanent location of the University is under consideration of the Central Government. The University made its beginning by establishing the Centre of Development Studies under the School of Social Sciences and Policy and launched a two years Master Programme in Development Studies in the academic session 2009-2010. The CUB Executive Council has approved 14 Schools of Studies representing various knowledge areas.

Objectives of the University

The objectives of the University shall be to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit; to make special provisions for integrated courses in humanities, social sciences, science and technology in its educational programmes; to take appropriate measures for promoting innovations in teaching-learning process and inter-disciplinary studies and research; to educate and train manpower for the development of the country; to establish linkages with industries for the promotion of science and technology; and to pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people, their intellectual, academic and cultural development.
